### Starter Questions

1. How did God speak to you through this passage?
2. What questions came to mind as you read this passage?
3. How is my life going to be different from reading this passage?

### Potential Discussion Questions

1. What keeps believers today from maturing in Christ and being able to understand and apply the “meat” of the Word?
2. Do you see any signs of carnality in your life? If so, what? How can carnality be removed or prevented from taking root in the believer’s life?
3. What kinds of service would you classify as gold, silver, and precious stones? What kinds of works would be wood, hay, or stubble?
4. What worldly attitudes seem to pervade the church and the lives of believers today? How do such carnal attitudes affect believers’ service for God? In what ways can believers express their loyalty and faithfulness to God?
5. Why is it important to see each believer as the temple of the Holy Spirit? How should that realization affect your actions, attitudes, motives, words, and worship?
