

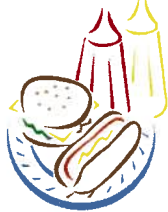

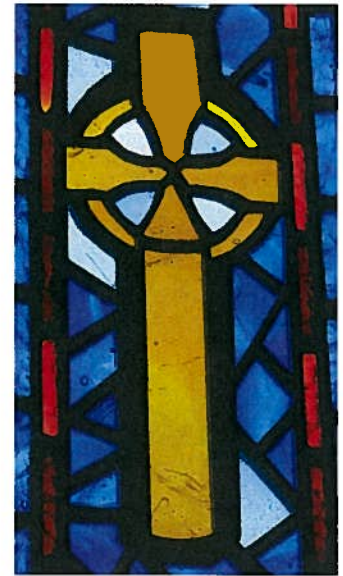

Hello! It's hard to believe it is already August. We hope you are having a safe, blessed summer. Everyone is getting very excited about the upcoming Vacation Bible School opportunity at Trinity Pres. We had more than thirty CLC children sign up to attend.

Recently, a "new" Mom signed up her 1 year old to attend the CLC – she remembers attending school at Trinity Presbyterian when she was a child! She said she still has a book about Mary and baby Jesus that her preschool teacher gave her. We also have another Mom who attended school here when she was a child, and her daughter is now here. It is great to see the circle continuing.

The CLC children have had fun and are remaining busy with various summer activities. We receive visits daily from parents who want to tour our school hoping to enroll their children in our fall programs. We have two new classrooms this fall and already our program is almost 100% full for the 2009-2010 school year.
