

PARKING

Parking is available at the Capitol Education Center Garage, 180 Central Avenue SW. To reach the parking garage, continue on Washington Street to the second traffic light (Trinity Avenue). Turn right on Trinity and go one block to Central Avenue. Turn right onto Central, go one block, cross Mitchell Street. The Capitol Education Center Garage is on the right in the next block of Central Avenue just prior to the Catholic Shrine of the Immaculate Conception. The garage is below street level. Turn right onto the ramp that will take you under the building. Once parked in the garage, take the elevator to the Upper Plaza (labeled UP). Walk across the plaza (in the direction of the Capitol and up the stairs. At the top of the stairs, turn left and enter through the double glass doors.

Who is *Moving Liturgy*?

Moving Liturgy Dance Ensemble is a professional liturgical dance troupe based in Burlington, North Carolina. The dancers in this ensemble have been sharing their ministry of dance as a visual enhancement in worship for over twenty years in churches and at national conferences. With a repertory that includes hundreds of classical and contemporary works, *Moving Liturgy* has shared liturgical dance with over 250 congregations. They combine the auditory and the visual for an multi-sensory impression. Whether from interpreting scripture readings through movement, or performing to sung or instrumental music, *Moving Liturgy* uses the human body to dramatize the life and teachings of Christ. At times these dances are reflective and thought provoking, and at other times joyful and celebratory. The dancers of *Moving Liturgy* were given the gift of dance, and through the artistic ministry, their gifts bring worship to a whole new dimension for the glory of God.
