Guidelines for Hostesses

1. In keeping with our overall theme, "In His Time," please choose an idea for your table based upon this Scripture ("A time or season to") and decorate your table accordingly. When you have selected a table theme (or need help), contact Pat Bryan, CWJC coordinator, **no later than May 4th**, at 919-231-3995 ext 113 or cwjc@raleighbaptists.org
2. We encourage having 2 hostesses per table. Hostesses will be responsible for selling tickets (\$10.00 each) for those at her table, 8 per table. Sometimes, we can assist with filling your table.
3. Guests may arrive in the fellowship hall of the church no later than 10:30 a.m. to be greeted and receive name tags **provided by their hostesses**.
4. Tablecloths need to fit (60") round tables, which seat 8. Formal or casual dinnerware can be used to carry out your theme. A container for your tableware is convenient for transportation, and can be placed underneath your table during the meal.
5. Centerpieces and table decorations should reflect your theme. Centerpieces should be at a height that will facilitate conversation and sharing, as well as viewing the stage.
6. **By May 12th, you will need to mail a check for \$80.00 for each table(s) to CWJC, PO Box 46659, Raleigh NC 27620.** No money will be collected at the door. If one of your guests has not prepaid, please pay for that guest and then collect at your convenience. Guests who have prepaid are more apt to attend.
7. It's good to have co-hostesses at a table. **Each pair of hostesses is responsible for a total of 4 food dishes: 1 meat-type salad, 2 vegetable/pasta/salads, and 1 dessert.** Each dish should serve approximately 8 people. Please label your food dishes. Served buffet style.
8. Coffee, iced tea, bread, sugar, sweetener, cream, salt and pepper will be provided by host church.
9. Church will be open on **Friday 10:a.m. – 8:00 p.m. for setup as well as on Saturday from 9-9:45 (no later).**
10. One of the best things about a Parade of Tables is being able to admire all of the beautiful table settings and theme interpretations. Guests can cast votes, \$1.00 each, for your favorite table and/or make separate donations to CWJC. All proceeds will support CWJC.
