Registrations are on a first come, first serve basis.

Raleigh Baptists have partnered with the Little River Association, Yates Association and Johnston Association for our annual training events. This year we are inviting these associations to join us for Mother/Daughter Camp too. Registration will open first to our RBA churches and then to neighboring associations.

This cherished event is a time for mother and daughter(s) to experience a wonderful time together in Bible study, crafts, games, singing and fellowship with other mothers and their daughters. You will also have a chance to meet a missionary and hear firsthand accounts of their experiences on the mission field.

Camp check-in time for each Session is set for 3:30 pm to 5:45 pm on Friday and Saturday. The program for each session begins with supper at 6:00 pm and concludes around noon the following day. A closing lunch will not be provided this year.

The cost is \$48.50 per person to cover lodging, meals, t-shirt, and registration. Discounts are available for mothers attending with more than one daughter. See registration form for rates.

Please make sure to indicate which session you are attending. There is a flyer enclosed for you to use in promoting this event in your church.

1. Registration opens on & mailings shall be postmarked **no earlier than:**
January 25, 2010 for RBA churches
February 8, 2010 for other associations
2. Registration closes on **February 26, 2010 for RBA churches** and **March 5, 2010 for other associations.**
3. Because space is limited, registrations will be handled on a **first-come-first-served basis. No phone/email registrations**
4. Open to girls in 1st to 4th grades.
5. If a group is attending, all registrations should be mailed in the same envelope by the church's designated contact. Please only one contact per church.
6. **Please indicate 1st and 2nd choice for the session you want to attend.** Every effort will be made to accommodate the 1st choice of each group but due to space limitations your 2nd choice may be used.
7. **Group confirmation/receipt will be emailed to the church's contact** when your registration is received. Then once camp registration is closed you will receive a confirmation packet which will include a map to camp, suggested packing list, and other information to be copied and shared with your campers.
8. **Completed forms must accompany fees for registration to be confirmed.**
9. **Each mother (or female guardian) and daughter team must complete a registration form.** If a mother/guardian has two or more daughters attending, she should complete one form for each daughter.
10. Please let mothers know that due to the popularity of this event they may be housed in different cabins from other members of their church but your group will be in the same unit.
11. **To register, please mail Church Registration List for each session attending, individual registration forms, and fees to Raleigh Baptist Association WMU, c/o Mary Langley, camp director, PO Box 46659, Raleigh, NC 27620-6659.**
12. **Because of un-welcomed guest in the cabins, NO FOOD or DRINKS in the cabins.**
