

ANNUAL MEETING

Because of weather and dangerous icing conditions, the Annual Meeting of St. Stephen's, Durham was postponed from the scheduled date of January 31, 2010. Per the Rector, the Wardens, and the Vestry, the Annual Meeting will now occur as follows:

Date: Sunday, February 14

Time: ~11:45 AM immediately following the 10:30 AM service

Location: Church (Nave)

Special Arrangements: Child Care, available from 9:15 AM through the end of the Annual Meeting; there is the possibility of pot-luck lunch afterwards for those who wish (announcements will be made, as appropriate)

This date is intended to meet the requirement of the By-Laws that the Annual Meeting be held no later than the second Sunday in February. The Annual Meeting Reports, printed for distribution on January 31 will be mailed to members with the intention of getting it into people's hands well before the meeting itself, and to give the 8:00 AM congregation (especially) time to peruse it in advance and then plan to return for the meeting if they wish. This arrangement also preserves the 9:15 AM time for Adult Forum, previously scheduled in the Davis Room with guests to discuss the topic and Immigration and Education..

With respect to the Vestry elections, the biographical information for those identified by the Nominating Committee has already gone out. People may still be nominated from the floor during the meeting itself; nominators should be prepared to provide a brief bio and confirmation that the prospective nominee is willing to serve if elected.
