

It saves time! It saves work! It simplifies your life! Electronic Fund Transfer (EFT) is now available at Grace Chapel. EFT is a reliable and safe automatic transfer program which allows you to make contributions without writing checks.

FAQs:

Q: When will my contribution be deducted from my account?

A: On its due date. You never have to worry about forgetting a payment or mailing it on time.

Q: If I do not write checks, how do I keep my checkbook balance straight?

A: Since your contribution is made at a pre-established time, you simply record it in your check register on the appropriate date.

Q: Without a cancelled check, how can I prove I made my contribution?

A: Your bank statement gives you an itemized list of electronic transfers. It will be proof of your contribution. Also, Grace Chapel will provide you with an annual giving statement.

Q: Is electronic giving risky?

A: Electronic giving is less risky than check contributions. It cannot be lost, stolen or destroyed in the mail. It has an extremely high rate of accuracy.

Q: What if I change bank accounts?

A: Notify us and we will give you a new authorization form to complete.

Q: How much does electronic giving cost?

A: It costs you nothing.

Q: What if I try electronic giving and don't like it?

A: You can cancel your authorization by notifying us at any time.

Q: How do I sign up for electronic giving?

A: Sign up online at www.grace.org/giving or complete and sign a print out of the PDF authorization form along with a voided check or savings deposit slip and mail to Grace Chapel EFT, ATTN: Accounting, 3 Militia Drive, Lexington, MA 02421
