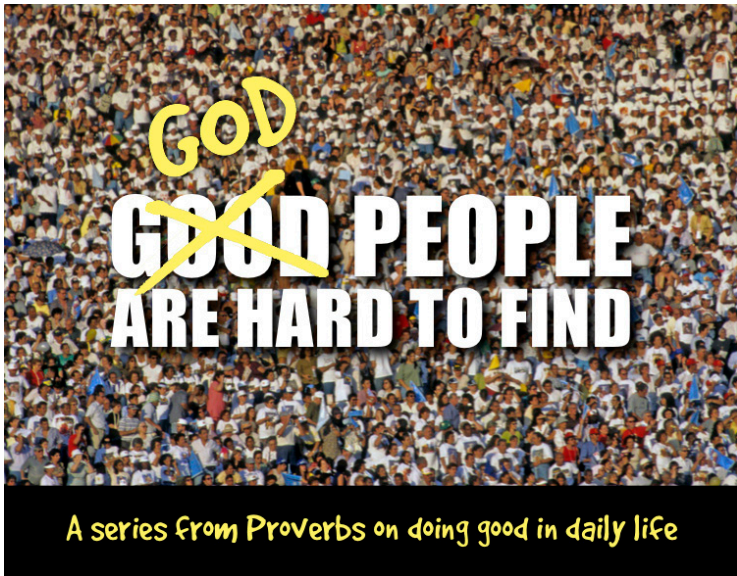

Important Information for Sunday, June 6th

As you may have heard, we have been notified that there will be a small extremist group from Westboro Kansas protesting Grace Chapel from the other side of Worthen Road on Sunday morning from 9:15am to 10:00am. This group has visited Lexington in years past. It seeks publicity by provoking communities and churches through their offensive statements and signs, and often sues organizations that engage with them. We want you to know that the Lexington Police will be here in full force and will be maintaining order at all times. The law does allow this group to peacefully make their protest.

There will also be a group of Lexington residents who plan to stand as a "Shield of Silence" between the protestors and Grace Chapel attendees, in order to prevent our normal worship from being disrupted. *Only those who have been through their extensive non-violence training are permitted to participate in the Shield.* We've been advised by the Lexington Police that Grace Chapel's most helpful response will be to simply ignore and refuse to engage with the group. Our pastoral staff will be guiding worshipers around where the group is protesting and into the side and back entrances. We are asking that everyone come and worship like we always do on Sundays.
