**Shuttle Bus Service:** Door-to-door service on Sunday mornings! Buses pick up and drop off in two places: (1) Lexington High School (front lot only) from 8:45am to 1:00pm; and (2) at the Fire Station - park in the lots behind the Fire Station from 8:45am to 1:00pm (please do not park in the Neillio's lot).
