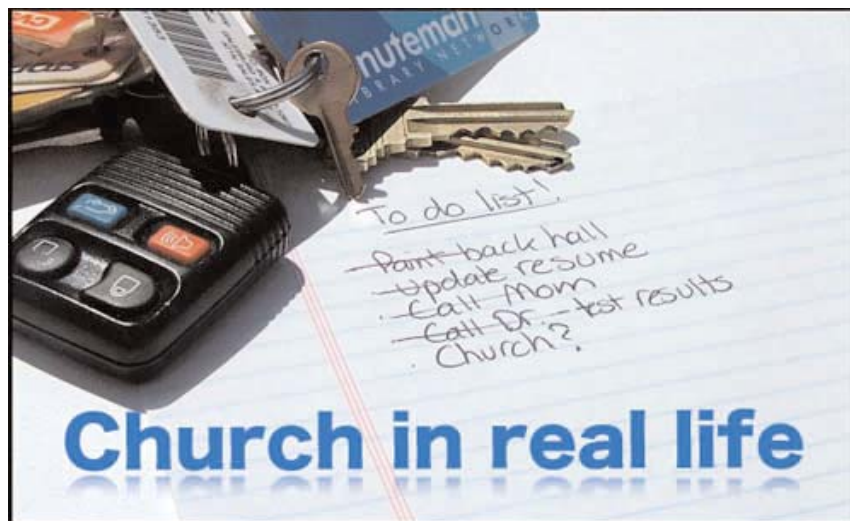

Did you know...

A number of months ago we looked into a way to save on electric usage and costs. Through this process we came across a company called EnerNOC which will pay us each month if we can decrease a good portion of our electronic usage, when asked during the hottest part of the summer.

By signing up for the program, Grace Chapel is agreeing to help reduce our demand for electricity during a specified period of the day. This will bring in revenue during a time when utility costs have risen. It will also help the New England power grid by not having to buy more electricity from other parts of the country, or build more power plants.

Power plants burn fossil fuel and in turn pollute the air and water through their emissions. Therefore, having less of them is actually better for our environment. Through this initiative we could see payments up to \$2,300 each month throughout the year.

### Financial Update

Thank you all for your prayers and participation in our annual congregational meeting last Sunday. Your affirmation of the contribution goal of \$6,598,500 for the current fiscal year allows us to continue to plan and execute our ministry and missions objectives. With budgeted contributions roughly equal to the total amount of actual giving last year, we are very pleased to report that we have received \$691,537 YTD through June 7. This exceeds giving for the same period last year by \$17,054 and puts us slightly ahead of our seasonally adjusted budget expectations! Thank you for responding so generously this past week and moving us "back in the black." Please continue to pray and consider how you might regularly support our ministry here at Grace Chapel, especially through the summer months.
