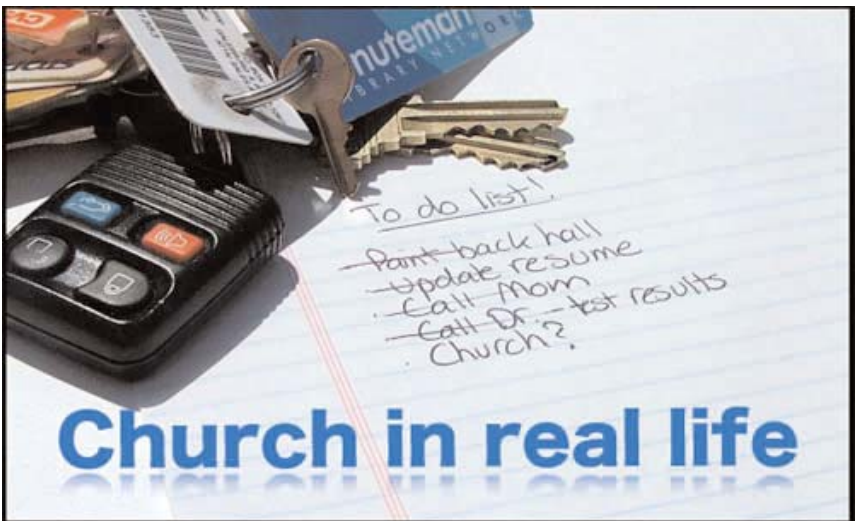

Did you know... A number of months ago we looked into a way to save on electric usage and costs and help preserve the environment. Through this process we came across a company called EnerNOC which will pay us each month if we can decrease a good portion of our electric usage, when requested during the hottest part of the summer.

By signing up for the program, Grace Chapel is agreeing to help reduce our demand for electricity during a specified period of the day. This will bring in revenue during a time when utility costs have risen. It will also help the New England power grid by not having to buy more electricity from other parts of the country, or build more power plants. Through this initiative we could see payments up to \$2,300 each month throughout the year.
