Work Ratio

5 hours per week broken down as follows:

2 hours on Sunday Mornings

½ hour of prep for small group

1 ½ hours of outside interaction with students

Monthly events and staff meeting add at least one more hour per week

Position Purpose

To be a disciple who makes disciples by building intentional relationships with students that encourage them to know Christ, love Christ and share Christ.

Organizational Structure

Each Sunday morning leader co-leads a small group of 10 – 20 students in the same grade and of the same gender. Sunday morning leaders report directly to the Pastor of Middle School Ministry.

Primary Responsibilities

- Attend middle school large group worship and teaching every Sunday
- Facilitate small group time, directly after worship and teaching for approximately 30-45 minutes.
- Interact with students and their parents outside of Sunday morning meetings
- Attend staff meetings approximately once a month
- Attend events and retreats
- Organize and execute small group events

Qualifications

- Committed relationship with Christ
- Worships regularly at Grace Chapel
- Growing in a small group or community with other Christians
- Pursuing a deeper walk with Christ through prayer, bible study and other spiritual disciplines
- Heart and vision for middle school age students (6th, 7th and 8th grade – ages 11-14)
- Desire to work as a team with 25-30 other volunteer leaders and partner closely with another small group leader
- Passion to reach out to the next generation of the church in creative and culturally relevant ways
- Teachable attitude that is prepared to learn and grow and be flexible.
