Work Ratio

5 hours per week broken down as follows:

2 ½ hours on Wednesday Nights (6:30pm – 9:00pm)

1 ½ hours of outside interaction with students

Monthly events and staff meeting add at least one more hour per week

Position Purpose

To be a disciple who makes disciples by building intentional relationships with students that encourage them to know Christ, love Christ and share Christ.

Organizational Structure

Each Wednesday Night Leader reports to Middle School Ministry Assistant who oversees and organizes all Wednesday Night activities.

Primary Responsibilities

- Participate in and/or lead large group games and teambuilding activities
- Build relationships with students through informal times of hanging out.
- Participate in large group worship and teaching times.
- Lead informal small groups occasionally
- Interact with students and their parents outside of Wednesday Night meetings
- Attend staff meetings which occur approximately once a month
- Attend events and retreats

- Pursuing a deeper walk with Christ through prayer, bible study and other spiritual disciplines
