Did you know?

Cornelius was the first recorded Gentile (Non-Jew) to become a Christ-follower. Centurion was the most important rank in the Roman military and came with relatively high pay and social status. A Centurion commanded a group of 100 soldiers, which was part of the larger Italian cohort of 600. At the time of Jesus, Centurions had to be Roman citizens of Italian birth.
