ST. MARY'S LAKEWOOD MOPS INFORMATION

Our MOPS group is chartered by MOPS International whose purpose is to nurture every mother of preschoolers by meeting her distinct needs to the glory of Jesus Christ. Although we meet at an Episcopal church, MOPS is a non-denominational Christian based organization. You do not need to attend church to join St. Mary's MOPS.

WHAT?

MOPS is a fun and exciting program for all mothers of preschoolers, from your first pregnancy until your youngest child finishes Kindergarten. Meetings feature speakers who address topics of interest to women, discussion time, craft projects, a continental breakfast, friendship and support. Once a mom's youngest child finishes Kindergarten, they "graduate" from our MOPS program.

MOPPETS

Our MOPPETS are the children who come with their moms to MOPS. It is a separate, secure counterpart program for these children ages birth through Kindergarten. The children enjoy free playtime, creative activities, story time, singing songs, as well as making new friends. Newborns (up to 4 months) are welcome and encouraged to stay with mom during the sessions. Once an infant reaches 4 months, they are able to join the MOPPETS program in the Nursery.

WHEN?

We meet the 2nd and 4th Thursday of the month from 9:15 a.m. to 11:15 a.m. The fall session begins the 2nd Thursday of September and runs through early December. We resume on the 4th Thursday of January and meet through May.

WHERE?

St. Mary's Episcopal Church, 10630 Gravelly Lake Drive SW, Lakewood – next door to the Lakewood Library, across from Clover Park High School.

REGISTRATION

Registration begins in May for the next year. Space fills quickly and we often have a waiting list. Space does become available during the year, and you may submit a registration form at any time to be placed on a waiting list. Women are received on a first come, first served basis; however, registration depends on the availability of childcare in our MOPPETS program. We can only accommodate a limited number of children in each age group.

COST

A \$20.00 registration fee is due with your registration form. You'll receive a "Moms Sense" magazine quarterly with your registration. The \$6.00 per meeting fee is paid in full at the start of each semester. Scholarships and alternative payment schedules are available. We want you to attend! If for any reason the cost of the registration or dues would prevent you from joining us, please let us know. All scholarships and money matters are kept **totally confidential**.
