### REPORT OF THE STATED CLERK June 12, 2010

#### OMNIBUS MOTION:

#### REPORTS:

At the request of the Nominating Committee I made the following appointment: Elder Kathy Adams (Perrysville) to Area 1 Committee on Ministry.

The Permanent Judicial Commission tried the matter of the Presbyterian Church (USA) v. Robert A. Hauser on April 28, 2010. The full decision will be read at the meeting and will be entered into the minutes.

The Synod of the Covenant reviewed the presbytery's minutes for 2009 and has approved them without exception.

The Administrative Commission we created to close the Malvern Bethlehem Church reports that its work is nearly complete. The building has been sold to another church. The legal description is as follows: Lots 209 and 210 in John H. Wilson's Second Addition to the Town of Malvern, Parcel Number 07-0060015.000.

The following churches have been awarded funds from the Frank E. Clark Charitable Trust through the Synod of the Covenant:

- Mt. Hermon Presbyterian Church, Cambridge  
\$1,000 toward a new furnace;
- Brighton Presbyterian Church, Zanesville  
\$1,000 toward new basement windows;
- Hanoverton Presbyterian Church, Hanoverton  
\$1,000 toward storm windows;
- First Presbyterian Church, Minerva  
\$1,000 toward bathroom renovations; and
- Norwich Presbyterian Church, Norwich  
\$500 toward insulation.
