Adult Sunday School Classes

(Descriptions and Locations)

All Classes meet Sunday mornings at 9:45.

Young Adult Class Room 230 22-30

Our class is for young adults who are seeking spiritual growth, Christian fellowship, and service opportunities. We welcome you, whether you are single or married.

Couples in Christ Fellowship Hall 25+

We are couples with young children, ranging in age from our 20s to early 40s. We meet on Sunday mornings to grow in our Christian faith as parents. The scripture we use is the reformed tradition, which we study each week. We also enjoy our fellowship and offer support for each other.

Explorers Room 129 25+

Do you wish you knew more about scripture? You should join our class! We are Explorers of the Bible who come together on Sunday mornings and listen to lectures on scripture. We invite men and women of all ages to come and grow with us.

CSI Room 234 25-40

We are couples and single adults who desire a deeper understanding of God's word. We study Scripture using the Reformed tradition translation and references, while encouraging fellowship and support for each other.

Foundations 112/113 Light House 30-50

This class is for couples with elementary and youth aged children who are interested in laying the right foundation to help build a strong family of believers.

Bridgebuilders Room 230 30+

This class is for couples with youth-aged children. We study Biblical themes as they relate to both individual and family issues.

New Genesis Room 235 40+

This class is for adults seeking interactive fellowship with other believers and an in-depth journey through the Bible.

Agape Room 139 Light House All Ages

We welcome couples and singles of all ages.

Faith and Life Room 232 40s+

This class openly discusses spiritual issues that face the individual and the family in light of scripture. Contemporary literature and materials are also used in the quest for further Christian growth.

The Open Door Room 203 40s+

This is a scripture based Sunday School class with emphasis on God's Word and its application to everyday life

Good News Room 202 50s+

This is an adult class that focuses on the Good News of God's word which encourages us in our everyday lives. Discussion in this class is welcomed.

Jerome Spires Room 152 50s+

This class enjoys Bible study using both denominational curriculum and contemporary Bible study books.

Kerygma Room 204 All Adults

This is a Bible study class that offers its members a deep look into the scriptures.

Primetimers Room 310 Fellowship Hall 50+

This class, composed of seniors 50 and older, uses materials from contemporary Christian authors and sources to promote interpersonal interaction among members and to strengthen Christian values in our daily lives.

Men's Class - For Men Only Room 130 Light House

This class, headed up by the Men's Ministry, will offer men (single, married, or divorced) currently not enrolled in a Sunday School class an opportunity for spiritual growth on Sunday mornings

Women's Class - Wondrous Women Room 233

This class, lead by Brenda Davis, will offer women (single, married, or divorced) currently not enrolled in a Sunday School class an opportunity for spiritual growth on Sunday mornings.

College and Career Class - Room 138

This class is for ages 19-25.

Reserve a Teacher

(From the SGPC Teaching Pool)

The following teachers are available:

Lee Fogle is offering a **3 week series on Evangelism**. Participants will learn a 10 Commandment approach to evangelism using a customized version of the Way of the Master Video series and will participate in role play practices using various common scenarios.

Dr. Jim Glatz is offering a **2-3 week series on Confirmation and Children** to teach parents how to prepare their children for taking part in the sacrament of communion.

Donnelle Glatz has two offerings:

1. a **2-week discussion on "A Structured Prayer Life."** We'll explore consistency, format, prayer systems, praise, journaling and Scripture in prayer. Participants will be challenged to try new methods so that their intimate times with the Lord might be more regular and fulfilling.

2. a **2-week discussion called "Sowing Seeds of Service in Young Hearts."** Participants will explore ways to open children's eyes to local, national, and worldwide needs. We'll share ways to help kids see need and respond to it for the Lord's sake. Family readings, family service projects, & material sacrifice will all be discussed as we jointly seek to soften little hearts to the needy.

Mary McIlwain is offering an **8 week series on Joshua**. "If all you know about the Book of Joshua is the kiddie song, "Joshua fit the Battle of Jericho"?you need to look again. Is Joshua still relevant to New Testament Christians? Are issues of obedience, sin, repentance,...still relevant? This study may change your mind about studying the Old Testament when you realize how current it is!

Dr. Bill Johnston is offering a **2 week exploration of the American Church and the Presbyterian Church**. Who are all these current church groups? Also included will be a lesson on what Presbyterians believe, how we make decisions, and carry out our congregational life and ministry.

Carey Wood & Leslie Callison are offering a **1 week class on "Home Depot" Hospitality** designed to make the audience aware that it takes the entire congregation being hospitable to each other to make Saxe Gotha a warm and friendly place for members as well as visitors. We will discuss ways that everyone can participate in hospitality each Sunday.
