### The Street Crew: Responsibilities (Rain or Shine...Hot or Cold!)

- Waving to and greeting each person or family as they arrive for worship
- Assisting guests, once parked, with directions to their destinations
- Inviting guests to the Welcome Center

*(Whether you like big umbrellas, sporting a neon safety vest, or have always wanted to man a walkie-talkie, Street Crew is for you.)*

### The Food CREW: Responsibilities (Food & Schedule Times)

- Care for the CREW at large by providing breakfast (casseroles, doughnuts, coffee & juice)
- Help keep CREW on schedule by being our timekeepers.
- Drive fellowship with the rest of the CREW during break times.

*(Whether you fancy yourself a gourmet cook, enjoy the smell of doughnuts at Krispy Kreme, or have ever been handy with a stop-watch, clipboard and whistle, Food Crew is the answer!)*

### The Welcome CREW: Responsibilities (Greet & Direct Inside)

- Greet people as they enter and answer questions
- Give directions or even escort guests to their destinations.
- Staff the Welcome Center in the Fellowship Hall, and the Info Centers in Narthex and Atrium.

*(If you enjoy being a part of any Welcome Wagon, never meet a stranger, and have a great inner compass, you’ll fit right in with Welcome Crew!)*

**Rise and shine! – All CREW teams meet at 7:30 a.m. in room 151 for devotions, assignments and breakfast.**

## Frequently Asked Questions:

**How often will I serve?** Once every six weeks your team will gather in Room 151 for fellowship, food, devotions and then go serve in your assigned roles.

**Can youth serve?** Absolutely! We’d love for all High School aged youth to be a part of this ministry.

**Will you train me in my assigned role?** Yes – Whatever area you choose, we will equip you to serve.

**Why serve from 7:30 am - 12:30 pm?** We are approaching this as a team, and as such, you will be serving with people from all three services who volunteer, thus helping strengthen community at SGPC. It will also allow us, during the course of the morning, to make sure all positions are filled.

**Can I still worship?** You will have time, if you choose, to hear the message. . . but we ask that you be back to your post to serve on time.

**What if I already serve on Sunday morning?** Would you consider lining up a substitute for your role once every six weeks to serve in a way that helps us strengthen community at SGPC?

**How many people do you need?** Glad you asked. And now you’ll see why we need everyone to participate! Street Crew – 300 . . . that’s a team of 50 each week of the six week rotation; Food Crew, 120 . . . a team of 20 each week and then for the Welcome Crew, 180....30 to serve each week to cover all entrances and accompany guests to their destinations.

**Could my spouse and I serve together?** Yes. **What about child care?** We ask that you do not leave your children in care or programming from 7:30 am – 12:30 pm. Prayerfully consider how you can serve and still best meet the needs of your family.

**Again, why the once every six weeks?** We want you to be growing through worship and study each week but are lifting this up as a church-wide opportunity to serve together. If you would like to serve more frequently, you may, but please do not neglect your personal worship and growth.

**Is this just another program?** Not at all. We feel that each believer is called to serve. We would like for this to be an opportunity to strengthen the community of believers here at SGPC, while providing a culture of welcome and care to our guests. No matter where you are placed on the campus during the course of the morning, we ask that you remain in prayer for the ministries, services and people who gather each Sunday.
