Why we go . . .



- **Trip Dates: June 12-21, 2010.** Please be flexible within a day or so, as we are trying to negotiate the best air travel costs.
- Team leader: Lee Fogle
- Trip cost: \$2700. Price reflects transportation, 6-7 nights hotel stay, meals while in Kenya. Meals en route and on return are up to you.
- Opportunities to serve include: serving in the medical clinic, building a foundation for the new orphanage, making repairs to the existing orphanage, conducting youth ministry and an evangelical crusade in the village.
- Youth must be over 15, accompanied by a parent or another adult, who is responsible for them.
