

## RIDING THE CREST

### UPDATE ON THE CAPITAL CAMPAIGN OF PROVIDENCE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH

#### THE GOAL OF THIS CAMPAIGN

Over three years, raise \$2,300,000 to provide for crucial repairs to our existing facilities, to implement visionary restorations to our Historic Buildings and Properties, and to open the Treasure of our Back Property, preserving the gifts of those who came before us and preparing to Share the Gospel of Jesus Christ with the next generation.

#### APPROVED PROJECTS

The Goal of the Campaign was determined by the estimated cost of about 60 specific projects. The first five of those were approved by the Session to begin this spring. They were:

- 1) Replace HVAC units in the Sanctuary (2) and Chapel-in-the-Woods (1).
- 2) Complete detailed drawings to access the back property, allowing for the completion of the fire suppression system for the Youth Building and the Chapel-in-the-Woods.
- 3) Complete the fire pit and gathering area near the Youth Building to be used by our youth and mission groups.
- 4) Landscape around the Mills Building.
- 5) Re-roof several of the buildings on campus.

#### COMPLETED PROJECTS

-  Two new 15-ton HVAC units are now operational in the Sanctuary.
-  The Chapel-in-the-Woods has a new HVAC unit as well.

#### STATUS OF THE OTHER APPROVED PROJECTS

- We have awarded the bid for re-roofing the Mills Building, Administration Building, walkways, Fellowship Hall, Chapel-in-the-Woods, Youth Building, and cabin. The contract was awarded to JCB Roofing, a local, veteran-owned company. The shingles have been ordered and they hope to start with the Mills building by the middle of September.
- Some of the landscape work around the Mills building has begun, but will not be completed until the roofing job is finished. The committee is still working on safety and lighting issues in the area.
- The Plan for Providence Park (back property access, fire pit, etc.) has been approved by the DHEC. We are still awaiting approval from the Town of Hilton Head before beginning work on this project that will bring many needed improvements to the Youth Activity Area and Chapel in the Woods.
