PAVER TO INSCRIBE AND PLACE AT OUR CLASS OF  
1971 GIFT TO RUTGERS OF PAUL ROBESON PLAZA.**

Dear Rev. Carlos,

As Chair of the Rutgers Class of 1971 Milestone Campaign to Build Paul Robeson Plaza, I am writing to encourage you to join me, and many others, in contributing to the Class of 1971 Fund to cover the construction costs associated with this important project.

If you are in a position to donate \$1,000.00 to our Class of 1971 Fund by June 30, 2019, you will be entitle to inscribe a 12" x 8" granite paver for placement at Paul Robeson Plaza, our Class Gift to Rutgers. A dedication ceremony is scheduled at 3:00pm on Friday 4/12/19 at the corner of College Avenue and Seminary Place in New Brunswick, NJ. The ceremony and reception are open to the public and everyone is invited to attend to witness this historical event. Based on our research, there is no other monument in the world that celebrates and honors Paul Robeson to this unique and educational extent.

Of importance is that our Rutgers Class of 1971 Committee is seeking groups and organizations to participate in this project that are advocates of Robeson's legacy and contributions to the world, who like us understand his extraordinary significance to all humanity. We would welcome the involvement of the Community Church of New York. Your participation would include you amongst such other groups as "The Robey Theatre Company" in Los Angeles, "The International Longshore and Warehouse Union" in San Francisco and "The New York Labor Chorus". Paul Robeson is considered to be "Citizen of the World" and we would like the inscribed pavers at the plaza to reflect this recognition.

At this point in the process, your paver will have to be installed blank, but over the summer of 2019 a technician from the engraving company will visit the Plaza to apply your inscription. Please be assured that field inscriptions will be of the same quality as what is done in the factory.

Through use of the enclosed form, you can inscribe up to 5 lines of text, with up to 20 characters per line (with spaces and punctuation marks counting as characters), with words of your choice. It is our interest to have as many of our classmates as possible represented on Paul Robeson Plaza. Please call me at 732-501-4898 with any questions. Thank you.
