Facilitators for Future Groups

After an 8-Week Session

After the last scheduled session, groups may choose to continue or disband. Participation requires a willingness to accept future change knowing that the group's ability to grow is needs to allow new and familiar faces to promote diverse experiences.

Facilitators for Continuing Groups

Should the facilitator of a group that wishes to continue be unable or unwilling to stay with the group, a new facilitator will be recruited from within or outside the group.

#### **What happens at a session?**
