WHEN AND WHERE? — The weekend of April 20 to 22 at Stony Point Center in Upstate New York – about an hour north of NYC. Stony Point Center is more than a conference center, it is home to the Community of Living Traditions, a multifaith community dedicated to radical hospitality, non-violence and justice. The community has a deep appreciation for all faith traditions. They practice green living, and use locally grown food (much from their own garden) when possible for the healthy meals they serve. They work at being accessible to all. We will offer private bus transportation as in years past. We hope you'll join us. Meals are included. Any questions? TRANSPORTATION? — **The bus will leave the church promptly at 5:00 pm on Friday, April 20.** Let's gather at 4:30 pm, to be set for a timely departure. On Sunday, April 22 the bus will leave after breakfast for an anticipated 12 pm return to Community. The cost is \$50 per seat, round trip. Space on the bus is limited, so sign up early to guarantee space. Driving directions will be sent to those traveling by car.
