- ***WORSHIP, not perform <MOST IMPORTANT!>

We are here to worship God, not to perform. Our heart is to love God, worship Him, and serve by helping others worship Him.

-Every team member must have a personal relationship with Jesus. If each individual member is connecting with God on their own, we will as a team be more effective in leading others into His presence

- MUSICALLY SKILLED

While a worshiping heart is most important, a certain level of musical skill is required in order to be a part of the worship team. (This is why we have auditions)

- David and the Levites were “skillful”. We have responsibility to give our best

-TEAM WORK/ FAMILY

Ability to function within a team is necessary. This requires ability to communicate, listen, receive suggestions/ corrections, etc...

- the Levites- the early worship teams- were literally family. We are meant to be family, not just people that get a task done together.

APPROPRIATE DESS

- A general rule, common sense but must be stated ahead of time- all worship team members must dress appropriately on stage (not too tight, too low). No jeans or skirts above knees.

COMITTMENT

- Worship team involvement is a commitment. Rehearsals are Thursday evenings 7-9pm (sometimes till a bit later.) The 1st Thursday of every month, all team members are required to be at the meeting whether or not they are scheduled to sing/play for that week. Once you're on the schedule, you are expected to be there when scheduled, and on time.

- Every team member has a responsibility to communicate about his or her availability (with our administrator Vanessa or through planningcenteronline.com)

LEARN QUICKLY

- We work at a quick pace. We will often learn a new song on Thursday evening, and need to have it ready that Sunday (3 days later). Ability to catch on quickly is needed.

- If the worship leader provides youtube links of songs, listen to them prior to arriving at Thursday evening's rehearsal
