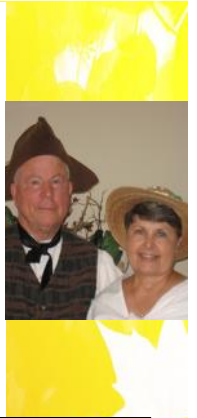

There is going to be a Ladies of Centre Garden Party!

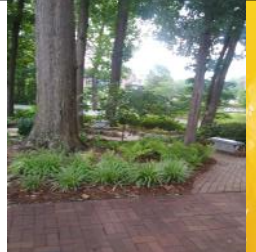

A Letter From the Pastor

As a Christian, you and I are not immune to bouts of discouragement, so why do we have to face it if we believe in God? Discouragement and disappointment are normal emotions we all experience, even for Christians. Acknowledging and understanding what causes our discouragement is important as we look to God to help up through those difficult times. Leslie Vernick, a writer for *The Association of Biblical Counselors*, suggests that there are four reasons why we get discouraged and disappointed.

1. We can feel let down by our friends and family. They don't understand what we're going through or don't offer to help as we wish they would.
2. We can find discouraged with life's circumstances. Despite our persistent and fervent prayers, things don't turn out the way we'd hoped they would.
3. We can be discouraged with God when we falsely believe God is against us, and because of that perspective, he temporarily lost hope in God
4. We can be discouraged with ourselves when we realize that we may not be as faithful as we hope to be. We too can feel discouraged and even depressed when we fail to live up to our own or someone else's expectations.

If you have been discouraged you are not alone. Even the strongest and best of people has discouragement. So how do we begin to deal with our discouragement? Vernick points to five (5) steps when you feel you are drowning in a sea of discouragement.

* Be honest. It does you no good to pretend you don't feel what you feel. Take action against a negative feeling by first admitting you have it. A strong Christian is someone who has learned what to do with them when he or she has these feelings and how to approach God with them.

*Take care of your body. If your body isn't working, your mind, emotions and will are also weakened. Sometimes the circumstances of life drain us dry, and we need to press pause, stop doing, and simply rest and refresh.

*Pay attention to your thought life. Learn to think truthfully and to take every thought captive to the obedience of Christ.

*Train yourself to "see" life out of two lenses at the same time. Try to see both the temporal (life is hard) and the eternal (God has a purpose here) at the same time.

*Press close into God. There is not doubt that life is hard, people do disappoint and hurt us, and we don't always understand God or his ways. Remember that God loves you and bought you with the price of His own blood to present you to Himself spotless and blameless.

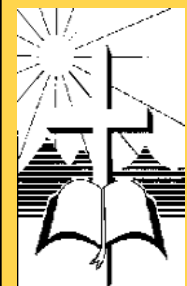
Leslie Vernick closes the article with one final tip. The best way to chase out a negative feeling is with another feeling. God encourages us in everything give thanks to Him. (1 Thessalonians 5:18) Gratitude is a powerful anecdote for discouragement. We can always look for things to give God thanks for even in difficult situations.

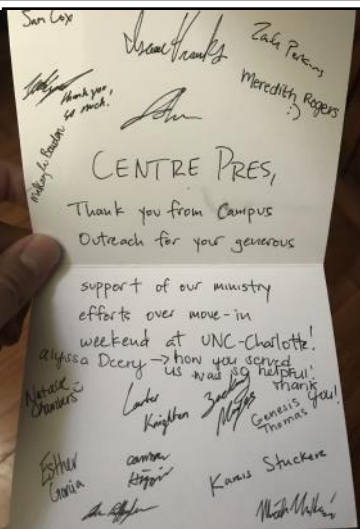
