Also, once a week, I hold a bible study on premises, and the members of both churches that I serve (Delaware Presbyterian and First Oxford) attend to provide much needed fellowship to drivers and travelers who are hungry for the Word of God and a community of brothers and sisters in Christ who care.

I have been at the truck stop for the last four years and there has been a long standing presence there. I would ask that you would consider additional support or support for the first time.
