## Message from the Director

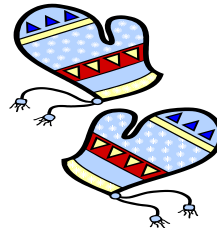
Welcome Back! We hope that each of you had a restful and joyful holiday. It has been wonderful for us to have some time with our families as well, but we are glad to be back with the children!

## Circus



Our annual Preschool Circus will be on Friday, Jan. 25 at 11am. It will be in Hanberry Hall (upstairs). Our 1's and 2's will be doing group acts with their class. Our 3's and 4's can have their own act or be part of the audience. A circus ticket will come home with your child that will need to be filled out with your child's "circus name" and what their performance will be. Here are a few pointers:

- Clowns, acrobats, tight rope walkers, magicians, jugglers, animals, animal trainers, tumblers or strong men/women are just a few acts that we have had in the past.
- Help your child use their imagination to create an act. It should be no longer than 1 minute. Keep it simple and without a lot of movements to remember.
- Costumes can be part of the act but are not required. Just a reminder that superheroes are not in the circus. Save these costumes for a dress up day later on in the year.

Following the circus, which ends around 12:30pm, school will dismiss. There will be no lunch or afternoon carpool.

## Carpool Reminders

Just a few reminders about carpool:

- Please slow down when entering the driveway for the church AND while driving through the parking lot and entering carpool line.
- Please use the correct driveways that are now posted in the front of the church upon entering or exiting the premises.
- Please do not talk on your cellphone while in carpool line.
- Please do not allow your child to "pretend to drive" while in carpool line. Have them stay in their carseat until a staff member gets them out.
- Please make sure you are buckling up your child COMPLETELY before leaving carpool. If you are not using the restraints on your child's carseat properly, you are putting your child's life in danger.
- Please make sure not to pull out of carpool line until the car in front of you does so or unless a staff member signals you to be cause of a delay ahead of you.
