Community Presbyterian Church is a small congregation located in Hampton, Virginia. Hampton is a coastal community with a population of approximately 137,000. Our church is 64 years old and is located in the Fox Hill section of the City. We have approximately 70 members and an average attendance in worship of 40-45 members and friend. While our weekly worship numbers are small, our outreach to our community has been large. Our ministries include our pre-school which serves up to 100 children for over 30 years, our MOPS (Mothers of Pre-Schoolers) program serving 17-25 mothers and children, our sandwich ministry serving 60-100 lunches monthly, Youth bell choir, our quarterly Red Cross Blood drives, and for over 40 years we have partnered with the Hampton Ecumenical Lodging and Provisions program in our community to feed and shelter the homeless in our community in the winter. Additionally, we host a monthly women’s bible study group, a seasonal adult bible study, children’s church, vacation bible school and have been a welcome host to a weekly Narcotics Anonymous meeting in our building. We have two part-time employees which include our church secretary and our music director/accompanist.

We are looking for a Pastor who will partner with us in our journey to look and move forward in our ministries and equip those ministries for the future. We have a commitment to the spiritual and physical growth of our congregation. We are in search of an individual who is able to minister to both the young and older members of our congregation including pastoral care and engagement. We are in search of an individual who is committed to the preaching and teaching of God’s word through their weekly sermons. Reading and interpreting the scriptures in a modern framework to reinforce the Bible as a living document. A warm and effective communicator with a focus and investment in the growth and development of the congregation and the community we serve.
