Our Promise to God

Our Promise to Our Children's Group

We promise to respect and to care for each other and to welcome other children and adult leaders in a friendly way.

We promise only to say words that are nice and kind. We promise not to gossip or talk poorly about others. If we can't say something nice, we shouldn't say anything at all.

We promise to listen to others and not to interrupt someone when they are speaking. Everyone deserves their turn to talk and I know that I will have my turn when they have finished.

We promise to obey our parents and other adult leaders.

We promise to keep our hands to ourselves so that we do not hurt someone else, by accident or on purpose.

If someone hurts us or is mean to us, we promise to tell the Director of Children's Ministries or another adult so that we may work out the problem in a peaceful and forgiving way.

We promise to forgive others and to ask for forgiveness from others for things we might have said or done to hurt or upset them.
