



Meet the Leaders

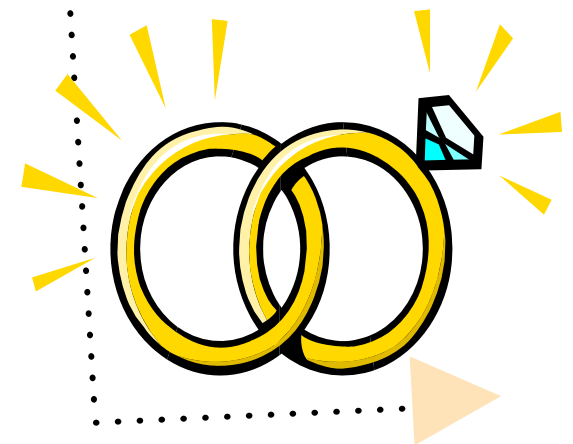
