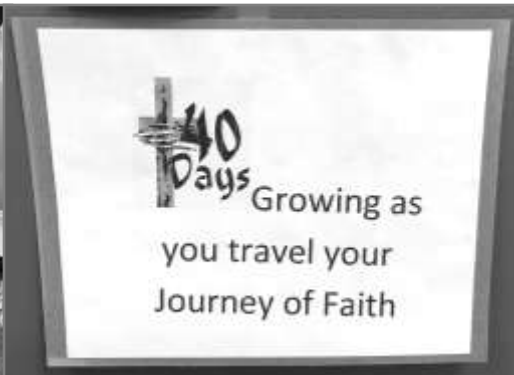




# Epiphany *Light*
