The drive will run from this Sunday to February 5th. Please help up to help our neighbors in need.

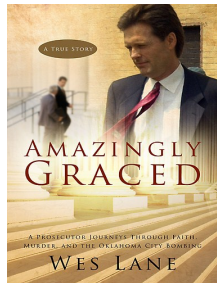
