
St. Peter's Annual Thanksgiving Food Basket Drive



1) Buy and assemble a complete basket.

Completed baskets need to be in the Narthex no later than **Sunday, November 18th**.

2) Monetary donation. If you are unable to shop, you may donate money and we will do the shopping for you! A complete basket costs \$60, including the turkey. All money must be in by Sunday, November 11th.

Please indicate your intention ASAP on the sign-up sheets located in the Narthex and outside the Chapel.

The town needs this info in advance.

ITEMS NEEDED FOR A COMPLETE BASKET

Please make sure to include each item listed below, or an equivalent amount.

2 boxes Stove Top or store brand stuffing

- 3, 15 oz. cans green beans or peas
- 3, 15 oz. cans corn, carrots, or mixed
- 3, 15 oz. cans yams
- 3, 15 oz. cans fruit cocktail or other fruit
- 2, 16 oz. cans cranberry sauce
- 2, 12 oz. jars turkey gravy
- 2, 7 oz. boxes instant potatoes

1 can coffee or small jar instant

- 1 small box tea bags (16)
- 1 box hot chocolate packets
- 2 half-gallons cider or apple juice (non-perishable)
- 1 box / tin assorted cookies
- 1 package candy mints
- 1 can mixed nuts or peanuts
- 1 lb. granulated sugar
- 1 package dinner-sized napkins (40) or holiday napkins

\$18.00 check for turkey (made out to St. Peter's)

Please place check or cash in an envelope marked "turkey" and leave it in the church office or in the offering plate no later than **Sunday**, **November 11**th.

DO NOT PLACE CHECK or CASH IN FOOD BASKET!!!

Pack your items in a strong, cardboard box or a large, Rubbermade-type basket.

All food baskets are given to needy families in Huntington through a program operated by the town.
