Notes from the Pastor's Desk...

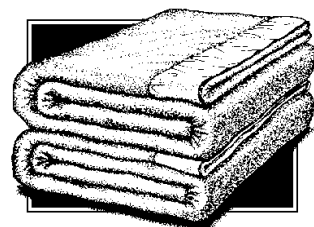
RIGHT MISSION

There's nothing like shopping for groceries when the weather forecast projects ice or snow and all the milk and bread have vanished. In times like these, we're forced to wait in line to check-out and pay for our purchases. It always makes my heart glad to see a manager calling for extra cashiers to open multiples lines and speed the customers on their way.

As Jesus traveled around the region, he saw how desperate the spiritual situation was. Matthew writes, "When he saw the crowds he had compassion for them because they were like sheep without a shepherd." He offered himself and he authorized his disciples to initiate ministry in his name. 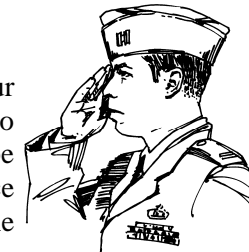
