MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

MEMBERS

(19 years and up)

- Complete Membership and Discipleship classes
- Complete Christian Care Class
- Actively participate in Learning Arm of the church (i.e. Bible Study, Saturday Church School.)
- Be a tithing member of the Church
- Actively participate in the YPD (Young People's Dept.) 5 – 25 years (where age appropriate)

(Under age of 19)

- Parent/Guardian are a member (i.e. have completed Membership and Discipleship classes)
- Actively participate in Learning Arm of the Church (i.e. Bible Study, Saturday Church School, Teen Bible Study)
- Actively participate in the YPD (Young People's Dept.) 5 – 25 years (where age appropriate)

NON-MEMBERS

- Parent/Guardian permission slip and Indemnity Form required to participate in ministry
- Actively participate in Learning Arm of the church (i.e. Bible Study, Saturday Church School, Teen Bible Study)
- Actively participate in the YPD (Young People's Dept.) 5 – 25 years (where age appropriate)

POLICY AND PROCEDURE

- In order to participate in any Promise House Ministry, youth must meet the membership requirements as well as:
 - ✓ Actively participate in the Promise House Youth Choir.
 - ✓ Complete a Disclaimer Form
- Parents, when dropping off and picking up children, must escort them inside the building to the Fellowship Hall to complete the Sign in/Sign Out sheet.
- Teenagers who come to church unescorted are required to provide a permission slip stating they are permitted to come and leave the church unescorted.
- There will be no leaving the premises once signed in. Requests to go to the store will not be honored.
- Parents are asked to provide snack and or lunch for their child/children that may be involved in several ministries for the day. Leaving the building will not be allowed.

- Older teens are not allowed to hang out at the church if they are not involved with that particularly ministry.
 - Youth are not authorized to touch/turn on the sound board or any church equipment.
 - If cell phones, I-pad, tablets, etc. are being used outside of purposes related to the meeting/ service; it will be confiscated and not returned until after the meeting/service comes to a close.
 - There is no running allowed in the building
 - No children are to be downstairs in the Sconiers Room/Fellowship Hall during service. All children are to be seated in the sanctuary during service with either their parents or ministry.
 - Children are to exemplify good Christian character. Rude and/or disrespectful behavior from the youth will not be tolerated. Youth that are found to step outside of character will be spoken to and parents will be notified. Failure to comply will result in further disciplinary action.
 - Children are to be escorted by either the parent or youth leader to restrooms during services/meetings.
 - As Worshippers Promise House youth are expected to attend worship service in its entirety. The youth, when ministering, are expected to stay for the entire service for the complete worship experience.
 - The sanctuary is Holy Ground and should be treated as such.
 - ✓ No food of any kind is to be eaten or allowed in the sanctuary.
 - Permission slips must be obtained and signed for all off-site engagements, trips, etc. in advance.
