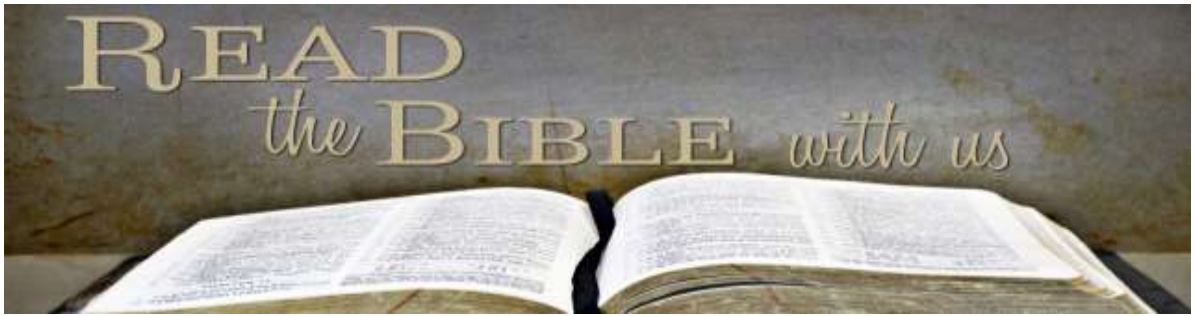


## **Our Pastor's Anniversary**

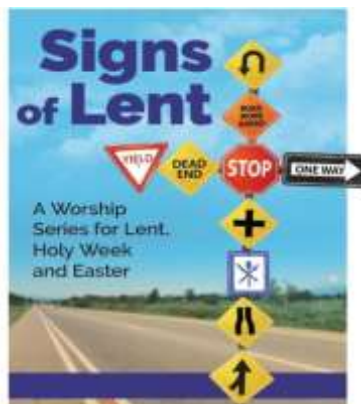

## **THANK YOU HEARTS IN MOTION MISSION TRIP**

Dear Trinity Congregation,

As many of you know, my class traveled to Guatemala shortly after Christmas. I cannot thank you enough for your overwhelming generosity and prayers. We brought so many donations that it took us about an hour and a half to check our bags. The Hearts in Motion staff was in complete awe that we were able to bring so much to hand out to those who truly need it. Every stop we made we were able to pass out many items to everyone there. My trip was an eye-opening experience that I am honored to have been a part of. We built gardens for three different day cares and one at the Hearts in Motion nutrition center in Gualan. We also educated parents and staff about sustainability, so hopefully when implemented they can save money on vegetables and herbs. Additionally, we talked with the Hearts in Motion staff about proper nutrition, how to spot malnutrition, hygiene, first aid, and motor development benchmarks. Finally, they were all trained in CPR. The whole experience was humbling. It was amazing to see God's hand in the lives of the Guatemalan citizens. They have so little, but they are still full of life and thankful to God for what they do have.

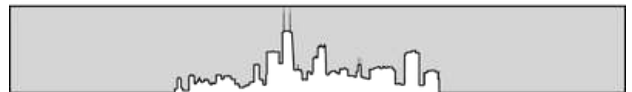
