**Lively Leisures will meet on Tuesday, May 21** and following lunch at 12:30 Dr. Gary Freeze, Williams R. Weaver Professor of Humanities, Catawba College will be the speaker. Dr. Freeze, a longtime member of St. John’s Lutheran church in Salisbury, is a recognized and honored expert on NC history, including the history of Cabarrus and surround counties. In particular,

he has written extensively on the social history of Catawba County, including the Lutheran roots surrounding the founding of Lenoir-Rhyne University. In addition to authoring an eighth-grade social studies textbook on NC history, Dr. Freeze has crated a major exhibit about the Andy Griffith show for the Mt. Airy Museum of Regional History. In his Lively Leisures appearance, he will review much of the founding history of St. James. His talk will include a new source about Rev.
