### **Council Meeting Highlights—November, 2018** *(full minutes available in church office)*

- \$300 was approved from General Fund for Anniversary Committee for PR expenses for Christmas Concert.
- Christian Education/Youth & family have decided to go back to Monday thru Friday VBS in 2019—week before July 4th. It was mentioned about the possibility of a joint VBS with Calvary Lutheran.
- Christmas Eve Children's Program will be at 5:00 p.m. Service.
- Mike Holt reminded everyone of the Youth Fundraiser—Port-A-Pit the—400 tickets pre-sold; Susan Spatz—Holocaust Survivor is unable to be here due to illness; Wild Caving Retreat is coming up; attendance for youth this past Sunday was 20 (with 5 from St. James) and Youth Worship attendance—34 (7 adults) and 2-5 College Online.
- Trunk or Treat went well and was well attended.
- There was discussion regarding children's Sunday School and the need for teachers.
- Property reported on several facility projects that are in process. \$2,400 was approved to be absorbed within budget.
- Pastor Tony passed out Time and Talent forms reminding those members that had not yet turned theirs in.
- Social Ministry—December 9th Opportunity House Meal—need volunteers and the committee has a Rise Against Hunger event scheduled in partnership with our Anniversary Committee for Saturday, February 2, 2019 to pack 10,000 meals.

- Approval for remainder of Cannon Trust funds to go to Cabarrus Bilingual Pre-School at St. James

Years ago, a member of St. James, Ray Hoover, set up a scholarship fund in honor of his son for the purpose benefitting individuals studying for the ministry. Wells Fargo Bank serves as Trustee and a committee of five individuals awards these scholarships yearly. At the present time, St. James representatives make up three of the five committee members (Norma Mosley, Mark Murphy, and Jodi Ramirez). The other two committee members are associated with our local public school systems. The awards are significant and can be renewed year to year. # *“Christmas Joy at St. James”*

**The Second Sunday Of Advent  
December 9, 2018 at 3:00 p.m.**

*Mark Frye, organ; Jenny Jones, violin; and Teresa Moore-Mitchell, soprano*

“Christmas Joy at St. James” will bring together our own master organist, an award-winning violinist, and a classical opera soprano in a festive Christmas concert. Mark, Jenny, and Teresa will present a program of familiar carols and Christmas music. The concert is one of several events celebrating our 175th anniversary. The event is open to the public.

Each of the three musicians is highly gifted in both training and performance.

Mark Frye has been organist and Director of Worship and Music at St. James for eighteen years. His mastery at St. James’ 2,500-pipe Hook and Hastings organ has earned him a reputation of renown well beyond Concord. In 2003 he led a 14-day European tour of the St. James Parish Choir, which sang for high masses in Rome, Venice, and Vienna. He holds a master’s degree in choral conducting with Winthrop University.

Jenny Jones began studying Suzuki violin at three and has studied at the North Carolina School of the Arts and Appalachian State University. She has performed throughout Europe and has earned numerous awards during the span of her career, including two Young Artist competitions. She plays professionally throughout the Charlotte region and is a founder of the Queen City Ensemble string trio.

Teresa Moore-Mitchell has appeared in countless opera and theatre roles, including performances in Carnegie Hall and Lincoln Center in New York and in numerous concert halls throughout Europe. Among her outstanding honors was the invitation to sing several selections for the opening banquet of Maya Angelou’s play “And Still I Rise” at the request of the founder of the National Black Theater Festival.

*A reception and tours of our historic church and our archives room will follow the concert.*

St. James was founded in 1843 as an offspring of Cold Water Lutheran and St. John’s Lutheran churches in eastern Cabarrus County. The original wooden church structure, along with a one-room schoolhouse and the beginnings of a church cemetery, were established along Corban Street in Concord on land now known as the old St. James Lutheran Cemetery.

By coincidence, the current St. James structure of Indiana limestone is also celebrating an anniversary, having been constructed 90 years ago this year.
