1st Corinthians 10:13

5. The early church was an expectant church. *v. 43b*
6. The early church was a sharing church. *v 44-45*
7. The early church was a worshipping church. *v. 46a*
8. The early church was a happy church. *v. 46b*
9. The early church was a contagious church. *v. 47a*
10. The early church was a soul-saving church. *v. 47b*
