BOUNDARY BREAKERS

What are some things you are confronted with that makes it difficult to stay within God's boundaries? These lessons will focus on some things that the enemy uses to entice us to cross the boundaries that God has set for all believers.

RELATIONSHIPS, REGRETS (DIVORCE), REMARRIAGE

I. Relationships

1. Relationships with an unbeliever. *2nd Corinthians 6:14*
 - Romantic
 - Business / Partnership
2. Romantic relationships should be between a male and a female. *Matthew 19:4*
3. In a romantic relationship it is critical that both individuals have a personal, growing relationship with God. *Genesis 2:16-17, 22*

II. Regrets (Divorce)

1. God hates divorce. *Malachi 2:16*
2. God permits divorce because of sin. *Matthew 19:7-8*
3. God permits divorce on the grounds of adultery. *Matthew 19:9*
4. God permits divorce when an unbelieving spouse decides to leave. *1st Corinthians 7:12-15*

III. Remarriage

1. Permitted when divorced for biblical reasons. *Matthew 5:31-32*
2. Permitted when a spouse dies. *1st Corinthians 7:39*
3. Encouraged if a person cannot exercise self-control. *1st Corinthians 7:8-9*

IV. Repent and Return

1. No matter what caused you to cross God's boundary – you can always return to God. *1st John 1:9*

Brothers and sisters, no matter what or who caused you to cross God's boundary, you can always repent and return!
