If you have friends who'd like to record, share this information!

Listen to the guide track on one device with earphones, while recording on a second device. Voice Memo works well, or many other recorders. Practice a few times before recording. (Please don't be discouraged - Even professional singers don't like what they sound like singing into a phone or other device by themselves.) When it's all together it sounds very different, even though the path to get there may seem unfulfilling.

After you record, listen to it – make sure you can't hear the guide track in your recording. It should only be your voice (or your family members, or your friends).
