2023 Minimum Wage in Virginia is \$12.00/hour
(up from \$11.00/hour in 2022, and \$7.25 prior to that)

40 hour workweek w/SS&Medicare taxes only deducted: $\$443.28 \times 50 \text{ weeks/year} = \$22,164$

30 hour workweek w/SS&Medicare taxes only deducted: $\$332.46 \times 50 \text{ weeks/year} = \$16,623$

20 hour workweek w/SS&Medicare taxes only deducted: $\$221.64 \times 50 \text{ weeks/year} = \$11,082$

NOTE: These figures assume no sick time, no vacation, no hours missed for meeting with children's teachers or taking them to the doctor. Assumes transportation works perfectly 100% of the time and every single thing in the year runs to plan.
