Please summarize the work of your team since last board meeting on one page or less

- Virtual Pathways continues to meet Sunday mornings at 9am. This Sunday school class is taught primarily by Aimee and has had an average attendance of 12-16 the last two months. We just finished up a unit about Jesus calling his disciples and will begin a new unit about how people welcome Jesus into their lives.

Future Developments:

- Third Grade Bible Workshop is typically held in January, but due to Covid, we will be postponing the workshop until the spring when we can meet outside.
- Baptism preparation season has been postponed and will kick-off in mid-April with an outdoor picnic luncheon, followed by 12 weeks of outdoor/virtual pastor's class, culminating in baptism late July/early August. We hope that warmer temps will enable us to be outdoors and in person more often for pastor's class and mentor candidate meet-ups.
- This summer Children's Ministries hopes to take over the east lawn with our large construction tents and set up an outdoor classroom where we can host Family Sunday School on Sunday mornings. While details are still in the works, the primary goal is to have families with children preschool – fourth grade join us for a Bible lesson and parent supported Sunday school activities. Our goal is to help families re-engage with the church as a unit after this long period apart.
- July 11-13 Children's Ministries is seeking to host an evening family VBS. Families will be invited to participate in an outdoor VBS that will begin with a picnic dinner opportunity at 5:30 and wrap up by 8pm. Theme and specific details are still in the works, but we cannot wait to welcome parents and their children back to one of Broadway's most cherished events.

RECENT DEVELOPMENTS

FUTURE PLANS

- MIDDLE-HIGH SCHOOLERS CONTINUE VIRTUAL MEETINGS EACH SUNDAY VIA ZOOM. A CORE GROUP OF APPROXIMATELY 8-10 TEENS PARTICIPATE WEEKLY WITH NUMEROUS OTHERS TUNING IN WHEN THEY ARE ABLE. IN ALL SEVERAL DOZEN TEENS HAVE PARTICIPATED VIRTUALLY SINCE THE NEW YEAR.
 - TEENS JUST CONCLUDED THEIR "REIMAGINE" SERIES WHERE THEY EXPLORED BCC'S NEW VISION AND CORE VALUES. YOUTH PROCESSED THE VISION IN A DEVELOPMENTALLY RELEVANT WAY AND OFFERED HELPFUL PERSPECTIVE ON WHAT THEY FEEL IS IMPORTANT GOING FORWARD.
 - LENT WILL FRAME THE NEXT VIRTUAL YOUTH SERIES. THE YOUTH TEAM DELIVERED LENTEN PRAYER KITS TO ALL FAMILIES WITH MIDDLE-HIGH SCHOOLERS. KITS CONTAINED SYMBOLIC ITEMS TO PROMOTE PRAYER DURING THE SEASON AND A LENTEN CALENDAR WITH 40 DAILY ACTIONS TO HELP TEENS PRAY, FAST, AND GIVE THROUGHOUT.
 - TABY LANE HAS BEGUN INITIAL CALENDARING AND PLANNING FOR YOUTH SUNDAY. YOUTH SUNDAY WILL TAKE PLACE MAY 2ND IN A VIRTUAL FORMAT. SENIOR RECOGNITION WILL ALSO GET FOLDED INTO THIS EVENT.
 - THE YOUTH MINISTRY TEAM CONTINUES TO MEET MONTHLY. WE'VE FORMULATED A STATEMENT OF PURPOSE AND TERMS OF MEMBERSHIP FOR THE GROUP. WE'VE BEGUN TO EVALUATE STEPS AND APPROVAL NEEDED TO RETURN TO LIMITED YOUTH GATHERINGS IN THE SPRING. WE ARE ALSO ENGAGING IN LONG TERM PLANNING FOR A RENEWED YOUTH PROGRAM SLATED FOR SUMMER AND FALL.
 - THE FAITH FORMATION STAFF CONTINUES TO MEET MONTHLY. WE ARE CURRENTLY EVALUATING OUR PROGRAMS IN LIGHT OF THE NEW VISION AND SHARING CONVERSATION ABOUT DEVELOPING AN INTENTIONAL FRAMEWORK FOR LIFE-LONG FAITH FORMATION.
 - YOUTH – TRAILS AND TACOS WILL BEGIN HIKING AND BIKING. THE FIRST HIKE IS SCHEDULED MARCH 20TH AT 9 A.M. SATURDAY. WE WILL MEET AT ROCK BRIDGE ELEMENTARY TO HIKE THE PAXTON PASSAGE AND DEER RUN TRAILS. THIS WILL BE OPENED TO ADULTS AND FAMILIES, AS WELL IF THOSE YOUNGER THAN YOUTH WANT TO ATTEND WITH A PARENT.
 - AS WE TURN THE CORNER TOWARD SPRING AND COVID, WE WILL BEGIN TO ENVISION YOUTH GROUP MEETING OUTDOORS AT THE WORSHIP CIRCLE, INCLUDING MONTHLY GAME NIGHTS.
