

Code of Ethics for Board

As a member of the Broadway Christian Church (Broadway) board, I will:

1. Recognize our job is to ensure Broadway establishes policy and that the staff administers it.
2. Represent Broadway in a positive and supportive manner at all times.
3. Do my best to ensure The Church is well maintained, financially secure, growing, and acting out its mission.
4. Display courtesy in all board, committee and task force meetings.
5. Work to learn more about my job and how to do it better.
6. Keep informed of issues to come before the board.
7. Declare any conflicts of interest between my personal and professional life and my position on the board.
8. Recuse myself from any discussion or voting on any issue that may confer financial benefit on me or my relatives in our personal or professional lives.
9. Listen to other board members, staff and church members with respect.
10. Respect and support the majority decisions of the board.
11. Refer suggestions and concerns to the proper person or committee.
12. Represent the entire church and not a particular special interest group.

As a member of the Broadway board, I will not:

1. Use Broadway for personal or professional financial advantage for me or my relatives.
2. Discuss any confidential proceedings of the board outside the board meeting.
3. Promise before a meeting on how I will vote on any issue in the meeting.
4. Interfere with the duties of the staff or undermine their authority.
