

# Christmas Angel Tree

The Christmas Angel Tree is one of the most special outreach traditions at St. Francis.

The gifts provided by our parish will be for families and individuals from Lord of the Streets, The Beacon and the Positive Black Male Association; these are organizations supported by the Linda Sadler Memorial Fund, a St. Francis restricted fund.

## Gift requests will follow these guidelines:

- 🌲 Children 12 and younger may request toys and bicycles.
- 🌲 Children 13 and older will receive gift cards.
- 🌲 Single adults will make needs-based requests.
- 🌲 All families will be given a grocery store gift card.

**All angels on the tree will be gift requests.**

**Gift cards can be purchased without a corresponding angel.**

## IF YOU PREFER TO PURCHASE A **GIFT**

- 🌲 Take as many angel ornaments as you wish.
- 🌲 Return the wrapped gifts with the angel taped to the gift. Bicycles may remain unwrapped.

## IF YOU PREFER TO PURCHASE A **GIFT CARD**

- 🌲 Purchase as many gift cards as you wish, each in the amount of \$50, from one of the following: MasterCard, Visa, Target, Walmart, HEB, Kroger or Fiesta.
- 🌲 Drop the gift cards in the box by the angel tree labeled 'Gift Cards.'
