



Medication at School (Self Administering Only)

If your child needs medication during school hours, the medicine must be brought to the school office by a parent or guardian, and a Physician / Parental Authorization for School Medicine Self-Administration Form needs to be completed. Medication must be in the original labeled prescription bottle (or in the original packaging in the case of over the counter medications) appropriately labeled by the pharmacist, clearly marked with the child's name, prescription number, and description of medication and dose.

School personnel are not allowed to dispense any medication. Parents may choose to come in and administer the medicine personally. All medication must be kept in the school office with the exception of asthma inhalers. Students who suffer from asthma must have an Asthma Action Plan and a signed form for self-medication on file in the school office. Students are encouraged to keep their inhalers with them at all times.
