Serious Traffic Safety Concerns in Trinity's parking lots have been the topic of conversation in many meetings. The main concerns are as follows:

1. NO CELL PHONE USE ANYWHERE WITHIN TRINITY PARKING LOTS OR THE SURROUNDING AREA.
2. The speed limit is 5 mph. Trinity's parking lots where children are present is not an appropriate place to speed.
3. The Drop Off lane is for dropping off ONLY. The driver should remain in the driver's seat at all times.
4. Please do not pull around a car in the Drop Off lane. Everyone needs to be patient and stay in the line.
5. Please make sure all children exit on the driver's side of the car in the Drop Off lane.
