We are glad to have you worship with us and we hope that you are blessed by our time together. Here is some information to guide you as we worship together:

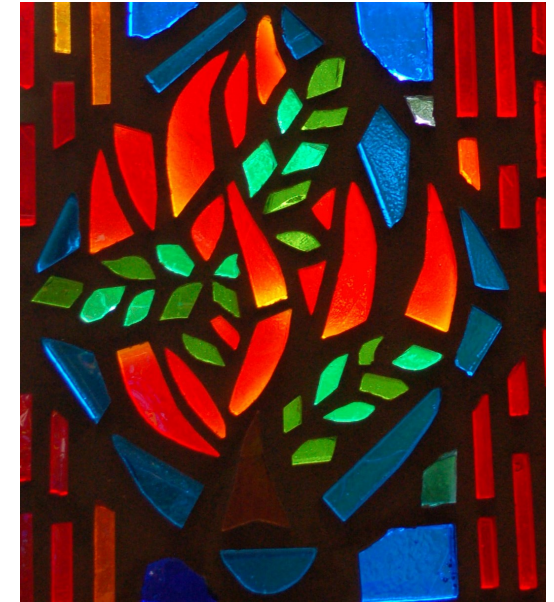
- Please fill out the **Ritual of Friendship folder**, when it is passed to you, printing your name, address and phone number.
