

Confirmations Requirements

1. Fill out registration form and return to office **NO LATER** than August 26, 2018.
2. Name a mentor by September 23, 2018.
3. Only allowed to miss 4 classes a semester (Fall of 2018 and Spring 2019)
(We meet in the Deacon's Room of the Youth Center on Sundays).
4. Participate in 2 church service projects: ie - Stop Hunger Now, SPHIN, Second Harvest, Habitat for Humanity, Ronald McDonald House in Greenville, attend Pilgrimage, VBS, etc.
5. Attend church at least 2 times a month.
6. Attend Holy Week services: Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, or Good Friday, participate in leading the Stations of the Cross, and Easter Vigil or Easter.
7. Attend Retreats: Spring Day Retreat and Fall Day Retreat.
8. Must schedule a 2-2 time with youth director and clergy.
(Meetings will take place in November 2019).
9. Attend the confirmation rehearsal in December 2019
10. Service of Confirmation on a Sunday in December 2019 at 11:15am and reception to follow service.

Materials Needed for EVERY meeting time:

1. My Faith, My Life by Jenifer Gamber
2. A Bible (NRSV or ESV)
3. Book of Common Prayer
4. 3-ring binder with notebook paper and tabs
5. pencil or pen
6. A willingness to learn and grown.

Confirmation Questions and Answers

When does the class begin and where?

The class will meet on Sunday morning during the Christian formation hour. **The first class is on August 26th and class begins at 10:05am and ends at 11:00am, starting and ending with prayer.** We will meet in the Youth Center; although, sometimes there will be occasional field trips (you will be made aware ahead of time).

What is the objective?

We wish for each confirmand to learn more about what it means to be a Christian and what it means to be in relationship to Christ. This is accomplished by participation in presentations, studying scripture, small group discussions, reflection, mentor relationships, prayer, fellowship and community within the Church and class members. It is our responsibility to adequately prepare the confirmands so that in December 2019 they are ready to publicly affirm their faith and commitment to the responsibilities of their Baptisms.
