Session Notes—June 16, 2015

The Session meeting opened with prayer from Pastor Dave and dinner was provided by Chris Burt. Kathy Kettlewell and Natalie Weinsz were guests as the meeting opened. They presented the updated Employee Handbook for approval. After discussion, the Session approved the adoption of the handbook. Natalie also brought forward updated job descriptions for the Business Administrator and Assistant Treasurer. After discussion, Session approved the updated versions. Bridgette Neisel from Stark County Community Foundation along with Jack Burnquist from the Endowment Committee then joined the meeting. Bridgette provided a summary of what they can do from an investment perspective. Questions were asked and discussion followed. More discussion at future meetings about the possibilities of investing with them will follow. Next, a motion was received from the Policy Development Committee to accept the Interim Safe Conduct Policy for guidance to be effective from June 16, 2015 to December 31, 2015. This motion was approved. Discussion was then had around the annual scholarship money to be distributed to those who applied. A motion was made and seconded to approve the list as presented. The second cut of the budget was presented and discussed. A follow-up meeting will be scheduled to discuss and approve a final budget. The May meeting minutes, clerks report and Communion schedule for 2015-2016 were reviewed and approved. Session then set August 30, 2015 for the annual congregational meeting and to review the annual report. A motion to hold a congregational meeting on June 28, 2015 for the business of electing Deacons, Elders and Nominating Committee was made, seconded and approved. The Session then ended their evening by moving to the chapel for worship led by elder James Smith.
